As a special added attraction this year, they will have the *Live and Learn Train* which provides train rides for kids. It will be in operation behind the depot during the same hours as above. The Norfolk Southern Railroad is providing an *Operation Lifesaver* diesel locomotive that will be on the tracks next to the depot. It will also be open to the public so you can climb into the cab. The newly painted caboose, next to the depot, will also be open to the public. This is a good chance to see what the Apple Valley folks have been up to during the past year. Everything is free of charge.
