


JOE NORRIS, MMR

Joseph Norris completed the requirements for and was awarded Master Model Railroader certificate number 546. He continues to amaze me with his creative talents.

At the August meeting, he brought some supplies to share with members, but the real delight were the two dioramas he brought. Both were built to show the capabilities of LEDs.

This one is lighted with a sting of miniature LEDs concealed in the bar across the top of the diorama. Power for the lights is transmitted through the thin metallic supports one positive, one negative.







This diorama shows how the colors can be adjusted to simulate the colors that occur in nature during sunset. As you can see in the picture, you have a brightening of the horizon that is controllable. Joe also had controls for the



street and building lights, along with the background lighting.

Both modules are amazing from both a lighting and modelling aspect! Thanks for sharing that Joe!
